





- 1. Get organized!
 - A. Create a Spreadsheet Template with:

 Color Codes, UTVA Emails, LC Emails, LC Name, Phone Numbers &
 a Communication Column
 - B. Copy/Paste grades from previous spreadsheets so you can compare and monitor the progress or lack of!
- 2. Send Progress Reports every chance you get!
 - 1. Present the data to the students so they can use it!
 - 2. Make video tutorials and post the links right in your weekly progress reports right next to the assignment.
 - Create an alternate assignment/assessment that is more accessible and fun and call it extra credit. They still learned the concept and can't resist "extra credit."
 - Offer real world incentives (gift card drawings)!



When the kids are gone, etc, also turn off social media, extra IMs, or whatever is distracting you.


Use that time as intentional and focused as you can.
